CALL FOR POSTERS ICA JR

The Organizing Committee of the 57th International Congress of Americanists (ICA 2021) makes known the submission deadlines for scientific posters proposals for ICA Júnior 2021 that will be held on July 18, 2021, at Ciudad del Este. Paraguay.

I - ABOUT ICA JR

ICA Júnior is part of the schedule of the 57th International Congress of Americanists that will take place on July 18, 2021, headquartered at Universidad del Este (UNE), located in Ciudad del Este, Paraguay. This unprecedented event aims to promote an academic space which encourages the development of scientific initiation activity.

The purpose of this unprecedented event is to promote interaction between undergraduate students and ICA 2021 researchers and participants.

We welcome all students in this new academic space that aims to promote the development of scientific initiation activity. The congress seeks to promote interculturality and exchange of experiences, through discussions related to the 21 main and innovative thematic axes of ICA.

III - AUTHORS AND GUIDELINES

- 1. Each poster proposal may have a maximum number of 2 (two) students, and 1 (one) advisor.
- 2. Are able to submit the posters as advising students of any undergraduate course, provided with their link with an educational institution.
- 3. The advisor must be from the same educational institution in which the advising is enrolled.
- 4. The scientific poster advisers must be at least 18 years old on the date of the event.
- 5. Each proposal must indicate in addition to the authors' names, the name of the supervising professor, which must have a minimum Master's degree.
- 6. The supervising professor is allowed to participate in up to 3 (three) differentes proposals that have been submitted to ICA Junior 2021.

IV - GUIDELINE FOR POSTER PREPARATION

- 1. The format of the poster must comply with the dimensions of 90cm (width) x 1.20m (height), in baton and cord finish, printed in high resolution.
- 2. All posters must include the title in Portuguese and in 1 (one) second language to be chosen between English, French or Spanish. All posters must include the following requirements: font size 60 (sixty), Times New Roman, alignment centered, with bold single-spaced letters and

capital letters. The subtitle should obey the font size 60 (sixty), in the font Times New Roman, alignment centralized, with simple spacing and small letters.

- 3. Information about the author(s), including name(s), affiliation(s), qualification(s) must be written obeying font size 36 in the font Times New Roman, justified alignment.
- 4. The introduction, development and conclusion must be written obeying the font size 24, Times New Roman, single spaced and justified alignment.
- 5. The introduction of the topic must contain your presentation/main thesis and also the objective of search; problem, methodology used and its relevance and justification.
- 6. The development must present the main arguments of the research and its theoretical foundation.
- 7. The conclusion should present the main results, whether partial or total.
- 8. The design of the poster is optional, but must be clear and concise, attending the criteria template that will be provided by the Organizing Committee of the ICA 2021.
- 9. The no observation of these specifications will result in the automatic declassification of the respective proposal, thus excluding its appreciation by the Scientific Committee.
- 10. All students will be responsible for preparing and structuring their respective scientific poster for oral presentation

V - SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- 1. The student (s) must submit their scientific poster proposal in the period established in topic 2 of this Call for Posters.
- 2. The submission must be made exclusively through the official website of the event, available at the website of the 57th International Congress of Americanists https://ica2021.unicentro.br. The student (s) is/are responsible for completing the registration on the website.
- 3. In the act of submission, the author must indicate the respective thematic area and thematic group of interest, and also the title of the proposal.
- 4. Thematic axes and lines of research are available through the online site https://ica2021.unicentro.br/eixos-tematicos/
- 5. The thematic category of the submitted work is the one that will be evaluated and will compete throughout the Congress process and cannot be changed later.
- 6. Scientific poster proposals will be accepted under two categories: Completed and On Progress.
- 7. We strongly recommend all submissions use the word template provided by the Organizing Committee of the ICA 2021.

VI - SCIENTIFIC POSTER SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1. Scientific posters will be reviewed by a specific Scientific Committee defined by the Organizing Committee of ICA 2021 and decisions will be made available via email.
- 2. Successful posters will be judged on the following criteria:
- a. Quality and clarity of presented information on the poster(s);
- b. Relevance with the thematic category chosen:
- c. Technical quality and scientific robustness;
- d. Uniqueness:
- e. Scientific language.
- 3. All decisions made by our Scientific Committee will be absolute and final, with no possibility of appeal.

VII - DISPLAY AND PRESENTATION OF SCIENTIFIC POSTER

- 1. Posters must be displayed and presented orally on the day of the event, at a time to be established by the event's organizing committee.
- 2. Print and transportation of the scientific poster is student (s) responsibility.
- 3. Presentations should be made in the presence of evaluators appointed by the organization, consisting of a maximum of 10 (ten) minutes and a minimum of 6 (six) minutes minutes.
- 4. The presenter (s) will have an extra 5 minutes to respond if there are questions from the evaluators or the public present.
- 5. If there are two authors the presentation time can be divided between them.

- 6. The time allocated for the presentation must be carefully observed. Delays can compromise further activities.
- 7. The best rated work will be rewarded with a tour in the city of Foz do Iguaçu PR, chosen by the ICA 2021 Cultural Committee. If the work consists of two both advisers will receive such an award, including the Advisor.

VIII - GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1. The Call for Abstracts is carried out under the responsibility of the Scientific Committee of the 57th International Congress of Americanists (ICA 2021): Foz do Iguaçu Brazil, 2021, in observance of the rules of this Notice.
- 2. The List of accepted papers and the notices related to the selection process, the call and eventual communications will be published on the Congress official page, by the Committee Organizer.
- 3. Authors' registration fees will be available on the event's official website.
- 4. Guiding professors of scientific posters are exempt from payment.
- 5. Information regarding the place and time for the presentation of scientific papers and their respective Thematic Axes will be made available on the congress website: https://ica2021.unicentro.br.

IX - FINAL PROVISIONS

- 1. The students will be responsible for filling, at the moment of registration, the irup dated data and contacts, with a view to making possible communications to be carried out by the Organizing Committee of ICA Júnior 2021.
